NRA Junior Olympic Shooting Sports Camp/Top Shot Competition General Information

- **What is NRA Junior Olympic Shooting Sports Camp/Top Shot Competition at Camp Shands**
 - Camp is designed for any youth ages 14 – 21 that has an interest in shooting sports and runs June 17 – 23.
 - Participants will receive the best shooting sports instructions anywhere.
 - Junior Olympics Shooting Sports programs will be followed with scores passed along
 - Limited to the first 36 participants
 - Adults may attend to assist and observe or youth may participate as individuals.
 - Participants will camp near the range in tents with cots.
 - Youth will be registered in Venture Crew 1 in order to shoot pistol and large caliber rifles.
- **Marksmanship Programs**
 - Shooters will shoot at least 400 rounds of 12 gauge shotgun on our skeet and trap courses.
 - Shooters will shoot at least 500 rounds of .22 ammunition on our improved rifle course.
 - Archers will have almost unlimited access to the archery course, including 3D hunting targets and crossbow.
 - Participants will learn safe and accurate use of throwing tomahawks and throwing knives
- **Top Shot Shooting Sports Competition**
 - Participants will shoot competitively the last two days of the program
 - Top shot scores will be based on 25% rifle, 25% shotgun; 20% archery, 10% pistol 10% knife throwing, and 10% tomahawk throwing
 - Recognition
 - Top Shots 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will receive large trophies
 - Trophies will be given for the top shot in shotgun, rifle, archery, knife throwing and tomahawk throwing
 - Every participant will receive a participation medal
- **Cost and Registration Info**
 - Cost is \$295 if registered on or before May 25, 2012, \$325 after that date
 - Adults \$85 before May 25 and \$100 after May 25
 - Registration ends when all slots are filled or one week before each week of camp
 - Fee includes food, ammo, trophies, medals, NRA recognition and a Camp Shands Top Shot T shirt
 - Register using the attached registration form.

Camp Information

- **Check in** is 2 pm on Sunday June 17, 2012
- **Check out** is 10 am on Saturday June 23, 2012
- **Emergency Procedures**-All will be briefed on Emergency Procedures on Sunday evening.
- **Medical Forms** – Every participant and adult leader that is at camp for 72 hours or more is required to complete a BSA Medical form with a Physician's signature. Forms are available online or at the council service center. All medical forms should be turned in at check in.
- **Hydrate** – Hydration stations are available. Water is only 50 cents in the trading post. Watch for 25 cent water coupons.
- **Contact by Phone**-An emergency number that you can give to parents is (352-475-5080). Emergencies only.
- **HAZING AND INITIATIONS ARE NOT TOLERATED AT CAMP SHANDS!!**
- **Camp check in and checkout**- Scouts or adults that leave camp during the week should check out and check in at Ames Lodge. Participants may only check out with an authorized adult.
- **Refunds** – Fees will only be refunded in case of serious illness or emergency. All refunds must be requested within one week of camp attendance. Refund requests must be made by email to debra.dow@scouting.org. Refunds will only be made in the amount of 80% of fees paid.
- **Mail Service**-Daily deliveries and collections are made at Camp Shands at the Ames Lodge. It is required to include Troop number and week number attending in the address.
